Then this workshop is for you! And it's **FREE!**

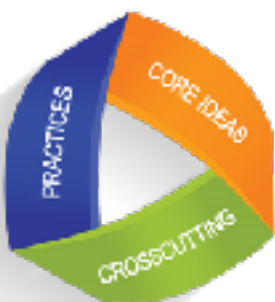
